THE FILMS:

Friday Night

Director Alexis Michalik is an actor, writer and founder of a theatre company who is currently directing his first feature film Escort Boys. Michalik is also known for his short film Pim-Poum le petit Panda, which was featured in the Cannes Adami Collection in 2014. He currently lives in Paris.

MESSIAH

A plump, hapless Irishman and his sophisticated Parisian girlfriend get more than they bargained for when they encounter a particularly mischievous stranger in the Australian Outback.

Director Damian Walshe-Howling is an actor and filmmaker who has a deep passion for storytelling in pursuit of culturally diverse stories and roles. Walshe-Howling is known for his

short films *The Bloody Sweet Hit* and *Suspended*, which recently screened at a number of international film festivals including St Kilda, Flickerfest, Nashville and Locarno in Switzerland. He currently lives in Australia.

A high school sophomore moves to a new school and decides to try out for the reigning state champion boys' basketball team. The player goes out and demonstrates extraordinary skill, worthy of making the roster. Then the team finds out the student's big secret.

Director Jeannie Donohoe is a filmmaker who is best known for directing and writing short films such as *Lambing Season* and *Public*. Donohoe is currently developing her first feature-length film *Flock*. She currently lives in Los Angeles.
